The MessageBox plugin has been totally revamped to a CSS design. You can override the CSS by configuring a setting in your [ConfigurationCFC](#) called `messagebox_style_override`, which is a boolean variable that defaults to `false`. You if you want to override, just set it to `true`.

Declare the setting

```
settings.messagebox_style_override "true";
```
